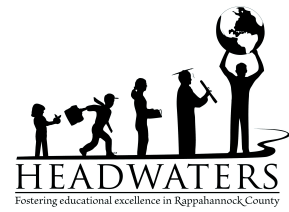

APPLICATION & REVIEW GUIDELINES

Preference is given to requests with a majority of the following attributes:

- Initiated and submitted by RCPS educators/staff
- Principal endorsed (**required**)
- Relates to, but reaches beyond, public funding capacity
- Stimulates curricular innovation, articulation, expansion, or diversity
- Includes as many students as possible without detriment to quality and effectiveness
- Extends opportunity to a diverse array of student ages, interests, talents, and needs
- Displays effort to identify and request other applicable sources of public or private funding
- Has potential for sustainable benefit to school system educational programs
- Promotes strong school-community relations, volunteer, or civic service

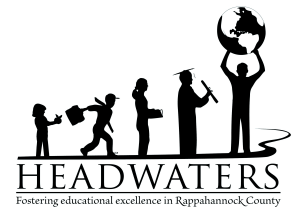
